

CAMPSITE SANITATION INSTRUCTIONS

Steps for sanitation of camp toilet facilities:

Mix $\frac{2}{3}$ of a cup of bleach to 2 gallons of water in sprayers

1. Ensure toilet facility is empty of people before beginning
2. Bleach spray
 - a. Spray sink faucets and sink basins
 - b. Spray outside of door frame and door handle (DO NOT SPRAY IN LOCK) of each stall
 - c. Inside stalls on toilet side, spray handicap rails, outside of toilet paper dispenser, flush handle, toilet seat - top and bottom, interior door handle, and interior of door frame
 - d. Inside stalls on shower side (if present), spray handicap rails, bench (if present), towel hooks, shower handles, front and back of shower curtain, inside door handle, and inside of door frame
 - e. Spray plastic sink fixture and basin
 - f. Spray urinals if present
 - g. Spray one of the two hose connections
3. Water rinsing - using the hose and hose connection that has not yet been sprayed, thoroughly rinse everything listed above and anything else that came in contact with bleach water
4. Coil hose back on hose reel and sanitize hose connection with a non-bleach solution (paper product with hand sanitizer meets requirement)
